Thanks you for your cooperation. Stay healthy!



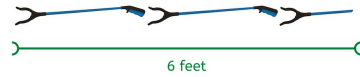

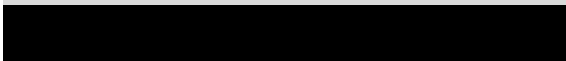

Site Coordinator Supply Pickup and Return Procedures

Due to COVID-19 and in the interest of keeping our KGMB staff and community volunteers healthy, we will bring your cleanup supplies to your vehicle. We will also come to your vehicle to collect them when you return them after your cleanup event. If you need to enter the office **you must wear a face mask**.

Please follow the steps below when picking up cleanup supplies:

1. Stay in your vehicle when you arrive in our parking lot (1313 W. Mt. Vernon Ave directly off of Emmer Lane) and call

your volunteers of safe distancing.
Use the link below to register your cleanup.

For those of you who have had to postpone a litter cleanup event, please don't forget to complete a new registration form once you have chosen a new date.

Also, we have initiated a new procedure for picking up and returning cleanup supplies - **Curbside Pickup!** Please read the adjacent article for information on how this will work.

414-272-5462 ext. 105. Please give the person who answers the last name and the group name on the Site Coordinator Registration Form as well as the type/color vehicle you are in.

2. A KGMB staff member will come out to you to confirm your order and ask for your driver's license/photo ID. A copy of your driver's license/photo ID will be made if you have reserved tools for your cleanup event.

3. A KGMB staff member will return your driver's license/photo ID and load your cleanup supplies into your vehicle. You will be asked to confirm receipt of the supplies by signing the registration form.

4. The tools will be disinfected and ready for your use and distribution.

5. Cleanup supplies should be returned on the Monday following your cleanup event. When you arrive in our parking lot, please call **414-272-5462 ext. 105** and give the person who answers the last name and group name on the registration form as well as the type/color of your vehicle.

6. A KGMB staff member will come to your vehicle to retrieve the supplies, the volunteer sign in sheets and wrap up reports and return to you the copy of the driver's license/photo ID.
